Dr. Geoff Gordon is a Partner Researcher at Microsoft Research Montreal, and a Professor in the Department of Machine Learning at Carnegie Mellon University. He has also served as Research Director at MSR Montreal, and as Interim Department Head and Associate Department Head at CMU ML. His research interests include artificial intelligence, reinforcement learning, statistical machine learning, game theory, multi-robot systems, and planning in probabilistic, adversarial, and general-sum domains. His previous appointments include Visiting Professor at the Stanford Computer Science Department and Principal Scientist at Burning Glass Technologies in San Diego. Dr. Gordon received his B.A. in Computer Science from Cornell University in 1991, and his Ph.D. in Computer Science from Carnegie Mellon University in 1999.
